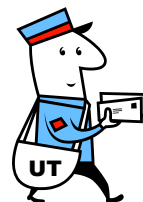

The University of Turabo in Puerto Rico in Partnership with PSU, Lebanon, Berks and Lehigh Valley is offering an innovative master's degree program, with a specialization in Teaching English as a Second Language (ESL).

Who should enroll?



Master's Degree in Education specializing in Teaching English as a Second Language

The program focuses on second language acquisition, methods of teaching, communication skills, and reading processes. It will allow participants to:

- ◆ Develop strategies for working in a multicultural education environment
- ◆ Support students with limited English proficiency
- ◆ Design, implement, and evaluate different models and educational structures supporting the teaching of ESL
- ◆ Work with information technology in the implementation of curriculum

The ESL program is designed for individuals who hold the Instruction I or II Permanent Certification in Elementary Education, and for any individuals holding Instruction I or II certificates who are seeking to specialize in ESL. Students enrolling in courses in this program should have oral and written competency in the English Language.

Program Requirements

Twenty-one (21) credits are offered by Universidad del Turabo and 18 credits by Penn State University. Students complete the Program in a 3-year period.

Completion of the 39 credit program will award participants:

- ◆ Master's degree in Education
- ◆ PA Special Certificate in ESL
- ◆ National Writing Project Fellow

Application Requirements

- ◆ Completed admission application
- ◆ Application Fee
- ◆ Official transcript of undergraduate degree or graduate degree
- ◆ Original copy of GRE, GMAT or MAT Scores
- ◆ Copy of marriage license or notice to resume prior surname if name on transcript is different from current name.
