Cory Varona-Corniel and Nicol Varona Cancelmo Cofounders of OCOA™ and Penn State Berks alumni

When sisters Cory Varona-Corniel and Nicol Varona Cancelmo were growing up in the Dominican Republic, they were taught that their natural curly hair was "pelo malo" or bad hair. It wasn't until they moved to the United States that they learned to truly embrace their natural beauty and curls. That's when they took matters into their own hands and founded OCOA™, a high-end curly hair care line for the confident Latina inspired by the beauty of the Dominican Republic.

Their journey to create OCOA™ began in 2018 when Cory became certified as a natural formulator and developed the first base for their products, while Nicol helped to test them.

According to the OCOA™ website, their purpose is to honor curly-haired Latina women, while helping them to find confidence in their authentic natural beauty by using high-end, clean, minimal ingredients from their homeland and their culture.

Both sisters are Reading High School and Penn State Berks alumni: Cory graduated with a B.S. in business with a finance and accounting concentration, and she went on to earn an MBA with a concentration in finance at Penn State Great Valley. She is the CEO of OCOA™. Nicol earned a B.S. in business with a marketing concentration and a minor in Spanish in 2013 and went on to earn her social media certification from Georgetown University. She is the CMO of OCOA™ and she is also employed as a Marketing Manager at SEI.

The sisters have been recognized with the 2023 Berks County Latino Chamber Young Entrepreneurship Award. They are also 2023 Black Ambition Top 50 Finalists, 2023 Square Forward Scholars and part of the Amika x SoGal Rooted in Growth 2023 Cohort.
