What is it?

Beaver is home to 12 varsity teams, numerous club sports, various intramurals, and recreation spaces. It features a 3,200 square foot state-of-the-art weight room. It is open to current students, staff, and faculty.

Which club & intramural sports are offered?

Club Sports: Vary according to student interest. Examples include women's equestrian; cheerleading; dance; and men's bowling, ice hockey, lacrosse, rugby, and volleyball.

Intramurals: Vary according to student interest. Examples include badminton, basketball, beach volleyball, dodgeball, golf, flag football, frisbee golf, horseshoes, indoor soccer, pool, softball, table tennis, volleyball, and wiffleball.

Summer 2022 Courses

- Summer Sessions:
 - Summer I: May 16 June 24
 - Summer II: June 29 August 10
- Summer registration is open and available on a first-come, first serve basis.
- Students can schedule classes at any Penn State campus!
- Stay on track towards degree completion by speaking with your academic adviser before enrolling!

IMPORTANT!

- Most summer courses are accelerated, covering about 15 weeks of content in 6 to 7 weeks.
- You can expect the pace of the course to move very quickly with the class generally meeting more frequently.
- On-campus housing at Berks is not available for those taking summer courses.




If you do NOT receive notices from instructors, do not assume that this means that you are in the clear!

COMMIT: Make improvements to see greater success.


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Additional Resources



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LIVING ON CAMPUS

REQUESTING A HOUSING CONTRACT:

- Log on to <u>www.eLiving.psu.edu</u> with your Penn State login information.
- Under the HFS Contracts icon, select 'Request Housing'.
- Choose the campus and contract period.
- Select the 'Request Now' button.
- The page will refresh with a confirmation statement.

VIEW INVITATION AND GENERATE CONTRACT:

- In <u>www.eLiving.psu.edu</u>, select View Invitation to view available housing options.
- Select the housing option you desire and click 'Continue'.
- (Optional) Add the PSU Access ID for your desired roommate and click 'Continue'.
 IMPORTANT: Not all housing options allow for a roommate.
- Review your selections and click 'Create
 Contract' to generate the HFS Contract for your
 selected housing option. If you added a roommate,
 that student will also be offered the HFS Contract.

ACCEPT YOUR CONTRACT:

- Select the **Shopping Cart** icon and view the offer.
- Click 'Begin Acceptance Process' to view and read the HFS Contract and Terms, Conditions, & Regulations (TCRs).
- Check the box to indicate that you have read and agree to abide by the TCRs.
- **Type your name** to electronically sign the HFS Contract.
- Click the 'Accept Contract' button.

A BERKS BITE: Quick Egg Sandwich



Ingredients

- 1 English Muffin, 1 bagel or 2 slices bread
- 2 Eggs
- 1 Slice of Cheese
- Salt & Pepper to taste
- Optional
 - Meat (e.g., bacon, sausage, ham, or turkey)

Instructions

- Toast your English muffin, bagel, or bread.
- Cook your eggs (see microwave instructions below).
 - Spray a microwave safe bowl with non-stick cooking spray.
 - Add 2 thoroughly whisked eggs.
 - Cook for 1 minute and 45 seconds in the microwave.
- Top your toast with a slice of cheese, egg, meat (if you chose), and a little salt & pepper to taste.
