## THE PENN STATE BERKS COHEN-HAMMEL FELLOWS PROGRAM

is a pioneering initiative that will help talented and engaged students to become proud Penn State Berks alumni and community leaders.

The program was established in Fall 2019. Four new students will be admitted each year, and all students must be accepted into a Penn State Berks four-year baccalaureate program with the intention of graduating from the college. Fellows will receive a \$7,000 per year scholarship, work closely with a faculty mentor and supervisor, give back to the local community through service and leadership, and receive additional funding for research, conferences, materials, and more.

**THE APPLICATION DEADLINE FOR CONSIDERATION AS A FELLOW IS NOVEMBER 16TH.** High school seniors are encouraged to submit their Penn State Berks admissions application and then submit the Cohen-Hammel Fellows Program application.
