Alternative Spring Break

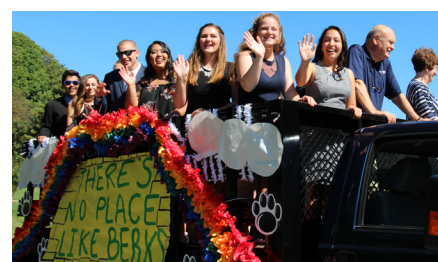
