Program Notes:

- [1] Students interested in pursuing a Masters in Social Work (MSW) may need to complete the following liberal arts core requirements with a final grade of a C or better in order to be admitted: English Composition, Human Biology, Humanities, Mathematics, Political Science, Psychology, and Sociology. Consult adviser for details.
- [2] MATH 021 recommended prior to taking STAT 200, but not required.
- [3] Students must complete one (1) General Education - Natural Science (GN) with a lab. Consult adviser for list.
- [4] Consult adviser for list.
- [5] A total of twelve (12) credits of internship experience is required in the junior and senior years. Internship experiences are typically scheduled in units of three (3) to six (6) credits in consultation with the Penn State Berks internship supervisor. Consult adviser for details.
