Agreement of Conduct

I understand that I am participating in a Penn State University credit course. 6. Inappropriate, disruptive or unprofessional behavior will not be tolerated.
7. Curfews may be imposed, if disruptive behavior becomes evident.

I also understand that these policies have a zero tolerance level and that I will be immediately sent home at my own expense for breaking any of these policies.
