**1** One science course must have a lab. One science course must be in biology, one in earth science, and one in the physical sciences.

**2** Effective for students graduating from high school in 2001 or after: If you did not complete at least two years of a foreign language in high school you must complete one semester here at MCCC or at PSU/BK. This is considered a high school requirement and does not count toward the PSU/BK graduation requirements.

**3.** See the website (<http://www.bk.psu.edu/academic/eedbl/eedbl.htm>) for course and non-course requirements to enter the teacher education program. For admissions as a 5<sup>th</sup> semester (junior) students must:

a. Have a minimum GPA for education majors of a 3.0 & successfully completed PRAXIS-I (Mathematics, reading, and writing). Students with a GPA less than a 3.0 will be admitted on a space available basis.

B Complete eighty (80) hours (at least 40 hours in a minority or special education setting) of work experience. See the website [http://www.ed.psu.edu/edservices/certification/workexp\\_req.html](http://www.ed.psu.edu/edservices/certification/workexp_req.html) for details

C Complete the following entrance-to-major courses (PSU course numbers) ENGL 15, Quantification (GQ) for six (6) credits, literature course, EdPsy 10 or HDF5 229 (or PSY 002 and Psy 213), EdPsy 014, EdThP 115, CI 295 (2 cr.), History 20 or 21, Natural Science (3 cr.).

**4** The Department of Education requires that all students in education majors submit Criminal record Check (ACT 34) and Child Abuse History (ACT 151) forms prior to begin placed in any educational field experience at PSU/BK.

**5** Application Deadline: Fall Semester- June 1 Spring Semester-December 1
